



Is the name registered by J. Barnard & Son to designate the series of Colours specially prepared by them in connection with their new process of Tinting Photographic Prints.

The accompanying example shows at a glance the excellent results that may be obtained by this process with a few Colours as well as the velvet-like softness, which is one of its chief charms.

The simplicity of the method appeals to all, as it needs no previous knowledge of drawing or painting, and skill may readily be acquired by anyone.

The process is applicable to all Photographic Prints which present the nature of surface required to take the colour, but not to olazed cust-ces Tor Orndento Pia

J.F., and gaslight prints lend themselves well.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE.

HAKE out a little colour on the palette provided and apply it to the photo by means of the small brush, putting it in small and separated patches on the surface to be tinted.

Next, rub over gently with a paper stump and so spread out and soften down the Colour.

Colours and Stumps should be selected as the nature of the work suggests. A very little practice will be needed to gain proficiency.

When the Tinting is completed, dust over with the larger brush to remove the loose colour and the process is complete except for fixing, which is accomplished by steaming over a pan of boiling water, or, if preferred, the result may be obtained by using Fixative solution applied by means of a spray.
